## 1. Unconditional

God's love is not based on your performance or worthiness.

Verse: Romans 5:8

Chew: "If I really believed God's love for me is unconditional, how would that change

my fear of failure?"

## 2. Eternal

God's love has no beginning or end.

Verse: Jeremiah 31:3

Chew: "If I really believed God's love is everlasting, how would that change my anxiety

about the future?"

# 3. Sovereign

God loves according to His own will and purpose.

Verse: Deuteronomy 7:7–8

Chew: "If I really believed God chose to love me, how would that change my sense of

belonging?"

## 4. Immeasurable

God's love cannot be measured or fully understood.

Verse: Ephesians 3:18-19

Chew: "If I really believed God's love is beyond measure, how would that change my

sense of worth?"

## 5. Unchanging (Immutable)

God's love never shifts or fades.

Verse: James 1:17

Chew: "If I really believed God's love is unchanging, how would that change my

response to life's ups and downs?"

#### 6. Steadfast

God's love is loyal and unwavering.

Verse: Psalm 136:1



Chew: "If I really believed God's love endures forever, how would that change my fear of abandonment?"

## 7. Patient

God's love is slow to anger and rich in patience.

Verse: Psalm 103:8

Chew: "If I really believed God is patient with me, how would that change my patience

with myself and others?"

#### 8. Kind

God's love is gentle and considerate.

Verse: Titus 3:4-5

Chew: "If I really believed God's love is kind, how would that change my self-talk?"

## 9. Forgiving

God's love covers all sin and offers complete forgiveness.

Verse: 1 John 1:9

Chew: "If I really believed God's forgiveness is complete, how would that change how I

handle guilt or shame?"

## 10. Compassionate

God's love sees your pain and moves to comfort and heal you.

Verse: Psalm 34:18

Chew: "If I really believed God's love is compassionate, how would that change how I

respond to my own suffering?"

#### 11. Faithful

God's love never fails, even when we are faithless.

Verse: 2 Timothy 2:13

Chew: "If I really believed God's love is faithful, how would that change my trust in Him

during hard times?"

#### 12. Sacrificial

God's love gives, even at great cost.

Verse: John 3:16



Chew: "If I really believed God's love is sacrificial, how would that change my willingness to serve others?"

#### 13. Personal

God's love knows you intimately.

Verse: Luke 12:7

Chew: "If I really believed God's love is personal, how would that change my loneliness

or insecurity?"

## 14. Rejoicing

God delights in you and celebrates your life.

Verse: Zephaniah 3:17

Chew: "If I really believed God rejoices over me, how would that change my

self-worth?"

#### 15. Secure

God's love cannot be lost or taken away.

Verse: Romans 8:38-39

Chew: "If I really believed nothing can separate me from God's love, how would that

change my fear of losing His approval?"

#### 16. Merciful

God's love withholds deserved judgment and gives grace instead.

Verse: Lamentations 3:22–23

Chew: "If I really believed God's love is merciful, how would that change how I respond

to others' mistakes?"

#### 17. Transformative

God's love changes us from the inside out.

Verse: 2 Corinthians 3:18

Chew: "If I really believed God's love is transforming me, how would that change my

attitude toward growth and setbacks?"

## 18. Enduring

God's love perseveres through all circumstances.

Verse: 1 Corinthians 13:7



Chew: "If I really believed God's love endures all things, how would that change my hope in hard seasons?"

#### 19. Protective

God's love is a refuge and shield.

Verse: Psalm 36:7

Chew: "If I really believed God's love protects me, how would that change my sense of

safety?"

#### 20. Generous

God's love gives abundantly.

Verse: Ephesians 1:7-8

Chew: "If I really believed God's love is generous, how would that change my attitude

toward giving?"

## 21. Gentle

God's love is tender and careful.

Verse: Matthew 11:29

Chew: "If I really believed God's love is gentle, how would that change how I treat

myself and others?"

## 22. Jealous (Rightly Protective)

God's love is zealous for our devotion.

Verse: Exodus 34:14

Chew: "If I really believed God's love is jealous for me, how would that change my

loyalty to Him?"

#### **23. Just**

God's love is righteous and fair.

Verse: Psalm 33:5

Chew: "If I really believed God's love is just, how would that change my trust in His

justice?"

# **24. Holy**

God's love is pure, without sin or selfishness.

Verse: 1 John 1:5



Chew: "If I really believed God's love is holy, how would that change my pursuit of purity?"

#### 25. Peaceful

God's love brings calm and wholeness.

Verse: Philippians 4:7

Chew: "If I really believed God's love brings peace, how would that change my stress?"

## 26. Hope-Giving

God's love inspires hope for the future.

Verse: Romans 5:5

Chew: "If I really believed God's love gives hope, how would that change my outlook

on tomorrow?"

## 27. Delighting

God's love takes pleasure in His children.

Verse: Psalm 149:4

Chew: "If I really believed God delights in me, how would that change my self-image?"

## 28. Affirming

God's love speaks blessing and affirmation.

Verse: Mark 1:11

Chew: "If I really believed God affirms me, how would that change how I handle

criticism?"

#### 29. Rescuing

God's love saves us from danger and despair.

Verse: Psalm 18:19

Chew: "If I really believed God rescues me, how would that change my response to

trouble?"

## 30. Overflowing

God's love is abundant and never runs out.

Verse: Psalm 23:5-6

Chew: "If I really believed God's love overflows in my life, how would that change how I

love others?"
